ESV 1 Peter 2:11-12 ¹¹ Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul. ¹² Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation.

yasha (יָשַׁע - Strong's 3467)

^{NKJ} **Exodus 2:16-17** Now the priest of Midian had seven daughters. And they came and drew water, and they filled the troughs to water their father's flock. ¹⁷ Then the shepherds came and drove them away; but Moses stood up and **helped** them, and watered their flock.


yasha (יָשָׁע - Strong's 3467)

Salvation – *past, present, and future*

ESV Exodus 14:28-30 ²⁸ The waters returned and covered the chariots and the horsemen; of all the host of Pharaoh that had followed them into the sea, not one of them remained. ²⁹ But the people of Israel walked on dry ground through the sea, the waters being a wall to them on their right hand and on their left. ³⁰ Thus the LORD **saved** (*yasha*) Israel that day from the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians dead on the seashore.

sow or scatter seed

Reward -

ESV John 4:35-38 ³⁵ Do you not say, 'There are yet four months, then comes the harvest'? Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest. ³⁶ Already **the one who reaps is receiving wages and gathering fruit for eternal life,** so that sower and reaper may rejoice together. ³⁷ For here the saying holds true, 'One sows and another reaps.' ³⁸ I sent you to reap that for which you did not labor. Others have labored, and you have entered into their labor."

Reward -

^{ESV} **1 Corinthians 3:5-8** What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each. ⁶ I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. ⁷ So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. ⁸ He who plants and he who waters are one, and **each will receive his wages according to his labor.**
