
#### Review –

- See how John's calling parallels our own





ESV 1 Kings 17:1 .... "As the LORD the God of Israel lives, before whom I stand, there shall be neither dew nor rain these years, except by my word."




<sup>ESV</sup> **1 Kings 18:17-20** <sup>17</sup> When Ahab saw Elijah, Ahab said to him, "Is it you, you troubler of Israel?" <sup>18</sup> And he answered, "I have not troubled Israel, but you have, and your father's house, because you have abandoned the commandments of the LORD and followed the Baals. <sup>19</sup> Now therefore send and gather all Israel to me at Mount Carmel, and the 450 prophets of Baal and the 400 prophets of Asherah, who eat at Jezebel's table." <sup>20</sup> So Ahab sent to all the people of Israel and gathered the prophets together at Mount Carmel.




Luke 3:15 As the people were in expectation, and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John, whether he might be the Christ . . .
