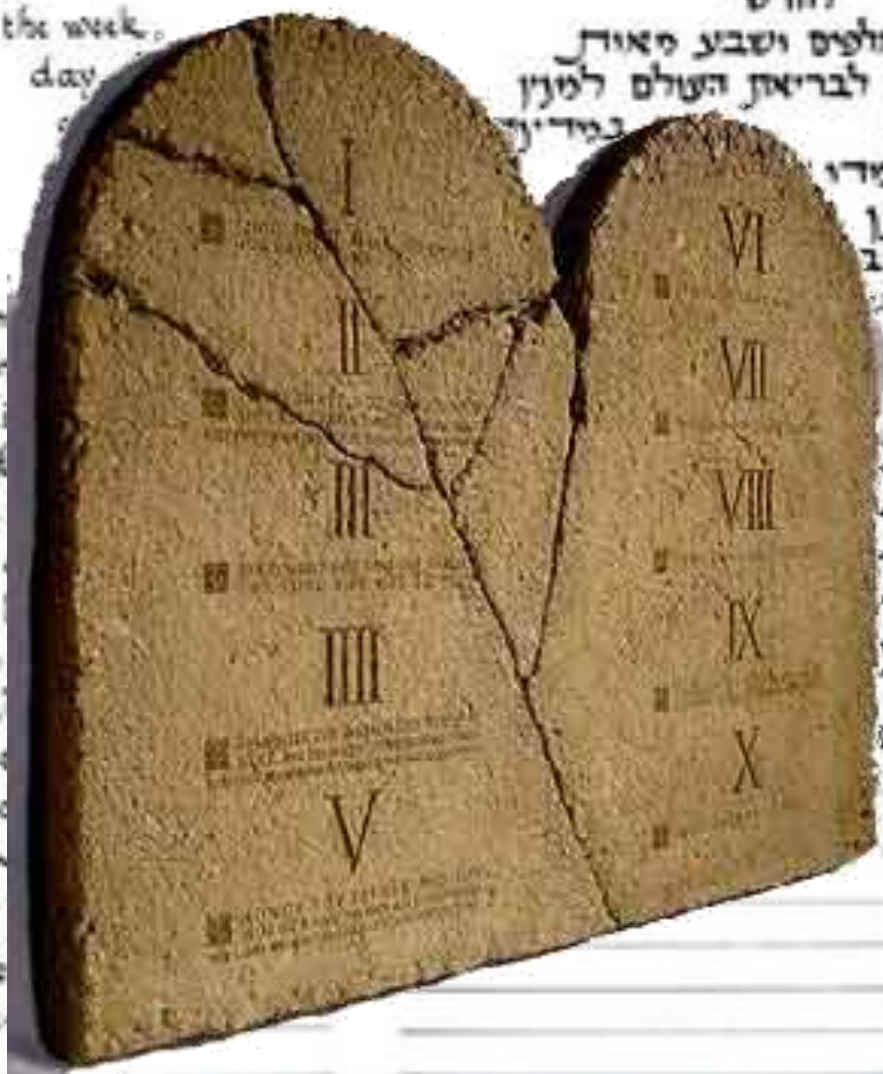

**ESV Isaiah 52:2-3** <sup>2</sup> Shake yourself from the dust and arise; be seated, O Jerusalem; loose the bonds from your neck, O captive daughter of Zion. <sup>3</sup> For thus says the LORD: "You were sold for nothing, and you shall be redeemed without money."

**NKJ John 14:2-3** <sup>2</sup> "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. <sup>3</sup> "And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.



**ESV Numbers 10:5-6** When you blow an alarm (*teruah*), the camps that are on the east side shall set out. <sup>6</sup> And when you blow an alarm the second time, the camps that are on the south side shall set out. An alarm is to be blown whenever they are to set out.



**ESV Zephaniah 1:14** The great day of the LORD is near, near and hastening fast; the sound of the day of the LORD is bitter; the mighty man cries aloud there. <sup>15</sup> A day of wrath is that day, a day of distress and anguish, a day of ruin and devastation, a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and thick darkness, <sup>16</sup> a day of trumpet blast (*shofar*) and battle cry (*teruah*) against the fortified cities and against the lofty battlements.

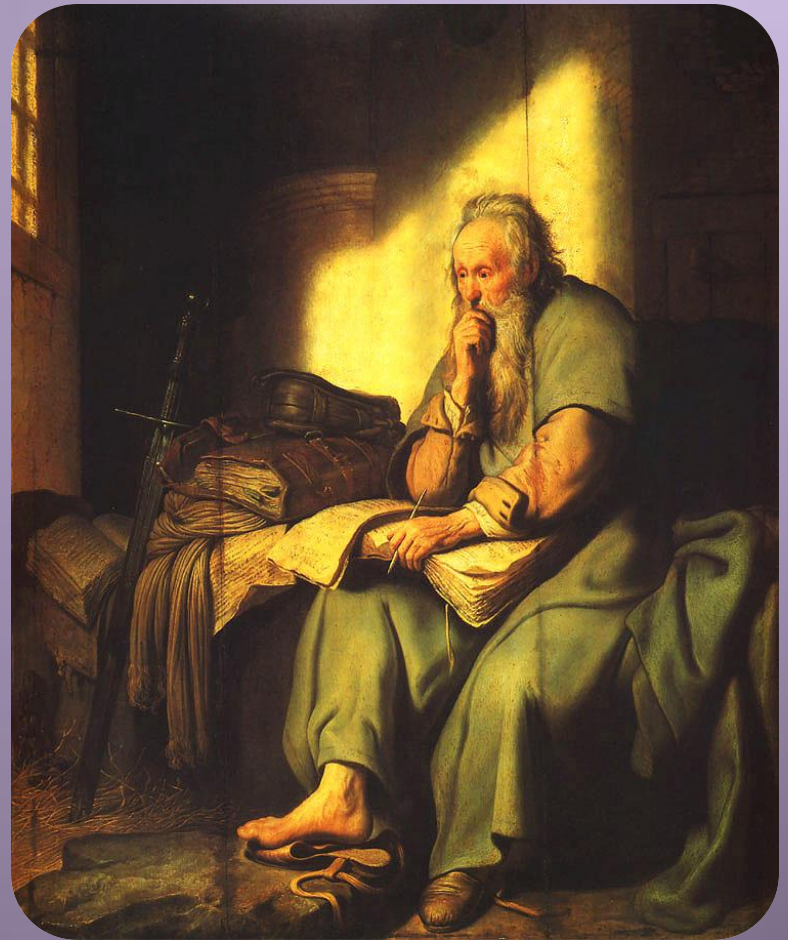



**ESV Zephaniah 1:7** Be silent before the Lord GOD! For the day of the LORD is near; the LORD has prepared a sacrifice and consecrated his guests.

**ESV Zephaniah 2:1** Gather together, yes, gather, O shameless nation, <sup>2</sup> before the decree takes effect- before the day passes away like chaff- before there comes upon you the burning anger of the LORD, before there comes upon you the day of the anger of the LORD. <sup>3</sup> Seek the LORD, all you humble of the land, who do his just commands; seek righteousness; seek humility; perhaps you may be hidden on the day of the anger of the LORD.

**NKJ 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17**

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. <sup>17</sup> Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.





**NKJ Joel 2:15** <sup>15</sup> Blow the trumpet in Zion,  
Consecrate a fast, Call a sacred assembly . . .

**NKJ Joel 2:16-18** Gather the people, Sanctify the  
congregation, Assemble the elders, Gather the  
children and nursing babes; Let the bridegroom go  
out from his chamber, And the bride from her  
dressing room. <sup>17</sup> Let the priests, who minister to the  
LORD, Weep between the porch and the altar; Let  
them say, "Spare Your people, O LORD, And do not  
give Your heritage to reproach . . .







**E NKJ Revelation 19:7** "Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready."



**NKJ Song of Solomon 3:11** Go forth, O daughters of Zion, And see King Solomon with the crown With which his mother crowned him On the day of his wedding, The day of the gladness of his heart.



**TNK Genesis 1:28** God blessed them and God said to them, "Be fertile and increase, fill the earth and master it . . .
