Vocabulary

- Yom - 3117 יוֹם - day, time, year; day (as opposed to night); a day as defined by evening and morning; a division of time
- Teruah - 8643 תְּרוּעָה - alarm, signal, sound of tempest, shout, shout or blast of war or alarm or joy
- Ruah - 7321 רוּעַ - to shout, raise a sound, cry out, give a blast ; to shout a war-cry or alarm of battle
- Shofar - 7782 שׁוֹפָר - horn, ram's horn
- Chuppah - 2646 חֻפָּה – a wedding chamber

Restoring the New Moon

Leviticus 23:23-24

Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ²⁴
"Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'In the seventh month, on the first *day* of the month, you shall have a sabbath-*rest*, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation.

To the Chief Musician. On an instrument of Gath. A Psalm of Asaph. Sing aloud to God our strength;

Make a joyful shout (7321 רוּעַ ruwa) to the God of Jacob. ² Raise a song and strike the timbrel, The

pleasant harp with the lute. ³ Blow (<08628> תִּקַּע taqa)

the trumpet (7782 שׁוֹפָר showphar) at the

time of the New Moon, At the full moon (3677 כֶּסֶף kece'),

on our solemn feast day. ⁴ For this *is* a statute for Israel, A law of the God of Jacob. ⁵ This He established in Joseph as a testimony, When He went throughout the land of Egypt, *Where* I heard a language I did not understand.

NKJ **Joshua 6:5**

"It shall come to pass, when they make a long *blast* with the ram's horn (3104 יוֹבֵל yowbel), *and* when you hear the sound (voice) of the trumpet (7782 שׁוֹפָר showphar), that all the people shall shout (7321 רוּעַ ruwa) with a great shout (8643 תִּרְוַעָה teruw`ah); then the wall of the city will fall down flat. And the people shall go up (5927 עָלָה `alah) every man straight before him."
