

Vocabulary

- Yom - 3117 - יוֹם - day, time, year; day (as opposed to night); a day as defined by evening and morning; a division of time
- Teruah – 8643 - תְּרוּעָה - alarm, signal, sound of tempest, shout, shout or blast of war or alarm or joy
- Ruah – 7321 - רוּעַ - to shout, raise a sound, cry out, give a blast ; to shout a war-cry or alarm of battle
- Shofar – 7782 - שׁוֹפָר - horn, ram's horn
- Chuppah - 2646 - חֻפָּה - a wedding chamber

Sing aloud to God our strength; Make a joyful shout (7321 - רוּעַ - ruwa) to the God of Jacob. ² Raise a song and strike the timbrel, The pleasant harp with the lute. ³ Blow (08628 - תְּקַע - taqa) the trumpet (7782 - שׁוֹפָר - showphar) at the time of the New Moon, At the full moon (3677 - כֶּסֶף - kece'), on our solemn feast day. ⁴ For this *is* a statute for Israel, A law of the God of Jacob. ⁵ This He established in Joseph as a testimony, When He went throughout the land of Egypt, *Where* I heard a language I did not understand.

Restoring the Shofar

NKJ **Joshua 6:5**

"It shall come to pass, when they make a long *blast* with the ram's horn, *and* when you hear the sound (voice) of the trumpet (7782 – שׁוֹפָר shofar), that all the people shall shout (7321 - רוּעַ - ruwa) with a great shout (8643 - תְּרוּעָה - teruw`ah); then the wall of the city will fall down flat. And the people shall go up every man straight before him."

When is the shofar blown?

- Mt. Sinai – restoring Torah to the people - Exodus 19:16
- Day of Atonement - restoring the land to it's owners - Leviticus 25:9
- Bringing the Ark to Jerusalem – restoring the kingdom of Israel - 2 Samuel 6:15
- Coronation of King Solomon – a type of Messiah - 1 Kings 1:33-34
- Laying the foundation for the 2nd Temple – restoring the Temple - Ezra 3:11
- The return of the Messiah – to fetch His bride - 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17
- The Day of Judgment – Tribulation/Birth Pains – restoring mankind to God - Joel 2:1

Yeshua's Promise to His Disciples:

Restoring the Hebrew Wedding

Paul Explaining the Resurrection:

¹³ But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep . . . ¹⁵ For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive *and* remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. ¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will **descend from heaven with a shout**, with the voice of an archangel, and with the **trumpet of God**. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

Restoring the Hebrew Wedding

The Kingdom - a Wedding Chamber:

In that day shall the branch of the LORD be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth *shall be* excellent and comely for them that are escaped of Israel. ³ And it shall come to pass, *that he that is* left in Zion, and *he that* remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, *even* every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem: ⁴ When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning . . .

Restoring the Hebrew Wedding

...⁵ And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: **for upon all the glory *shall be* a defence (chuppah)**.⁶ And there shall be a tabernacle for a shadow in the daytime from the heat, and for a place of refuge, and for a covert from storm and from rain.
