Galatians

Chapter 5: 13-26

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REVIEW: Galatians to this point

- Galatian congregations were a mixture of Jewish and non-Jewish believers
- Paul's letter was written primarily to the non-Jews, but Paul knew that the Jews would be reading it as well
- Letter motivated by the fact that some of the non-Jews were being swayed by "another gospel".
- The crux of the "other gospel" was that the non-Jews had to convert to Judaism, which implied observance to the "oral law"
- Paul makes it clear that if their standing before God was based on their works (converting to Judaism), then they would have to keep all the oral law to maintain that standing before God.

Called to liberty; only do not *use* liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. ¹⁴ For all the law is fulfilled in one word, *even* in this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." ¹⁵ But if you bite and devour one another, beware lest you be consumed by one another!

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"opportunity" – "aphorme" (Strong's 874)

"apo" (separation) + "hormao" (stir up, incite, to rush)

"aphorme" = "a place from which an attack is made"

NKJ Romans 7:8 But sin, taking opportunity having a place from which to attack by the commandment, produced in me all manner of evil desire. For apart from the law sin was dead.

NKJ Romans 7:11 For sin, taking occasion having a place from which to attack by the commandment, deceived me, and by it killed *me*.

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"flesh" = the oral traditions

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NKJ 1 Corinthians 10:23 All things are lawful for me, but not all things are helpful; all things are lawful for me, but not all things edify.

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NKJ **Leviticus 19:18** 'You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I *am* the LORD.

"faith-based righteousness" vs. "works-based righteousness"


"faith-based righteousness" vs. "works-based righteousness" spiritual walk" vs. "fleshly walk"

NKJ John 3:5-6 "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. 6 "That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.



NKJ **John 3:14-15** "And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, 15 "that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.







gratify the desires of the flesh. ¹⁷For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do.

righteousness, and you will not gratify the desires of works-based righteousness. ¹⁷For the desires of works-based righteousness are against faith-based righteousness, and the desires of faith-based righteousness are against works-based righteousness, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do.

you shall teach them the statutes and the laws, and show them the way in which they must walk (yalach) and the work they must do.







Mark 7:5-8 Then the Pharisees and scribes asked Him, "Why do Your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashed hands?" ⁶And He answered and said to them "⁷... in vain they worship Me, Teaching *as* doctrines the commandments of men. ⁸ For laying aside the commandment of God, you hold the tradition of men..."

NKJ Deuteronomy 30:1-3 "Now it shall come to pass, when all these things come upon you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and you call them to mind among all the nations where the LORD your God drives you, ² "and you return to the LORD your God and obey His voice, according to all that I command you today, you and your children, with all your heart and with all your soul, ³ "that the LORD your God will bring you back from captivity, and have compassion on you, and gather you again from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you.

outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told *you* in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

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Matthew 6:1 "Take heed that you do not do your charitable deeds before men, to be seen by them. Otherwise you have no reward from your Father in heaven. ,... ⁵ " And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites . . . Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward . . . ¹⁶ " Moreover, when you fast, do not be like the hypocrites, with a sad countenance . . . Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward."

NKJ **Galatians 5:22-23** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

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you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. ⁸ "By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. ⁹ " As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love. ¹⁰ "If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. ¹¹ "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and *that* your joy may be full.

NKJ **Galatians 5:24-26** And those *who are* Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

NKJ **Galatians 2:20** "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

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NKJ **Isaiah 11:13** Also the envy of Ephraim shall depart, And the adversaries of Judah shall be cut off; Ephraim shall not envy Judah, And Judah shall not harass Ephraim.

REVIEW: Galatians 5:13-26

- Though Paul is confident that most of the Galatians will abandon the "other gospel" of the perpetrators, he fears that the problem may eventually divide the congregation, therefore . . .
- He instructs them to walk foremost within the instructions of the written Torah, which if they do so they will . . .
- Will accentuate joy and godly love within the fellowship
