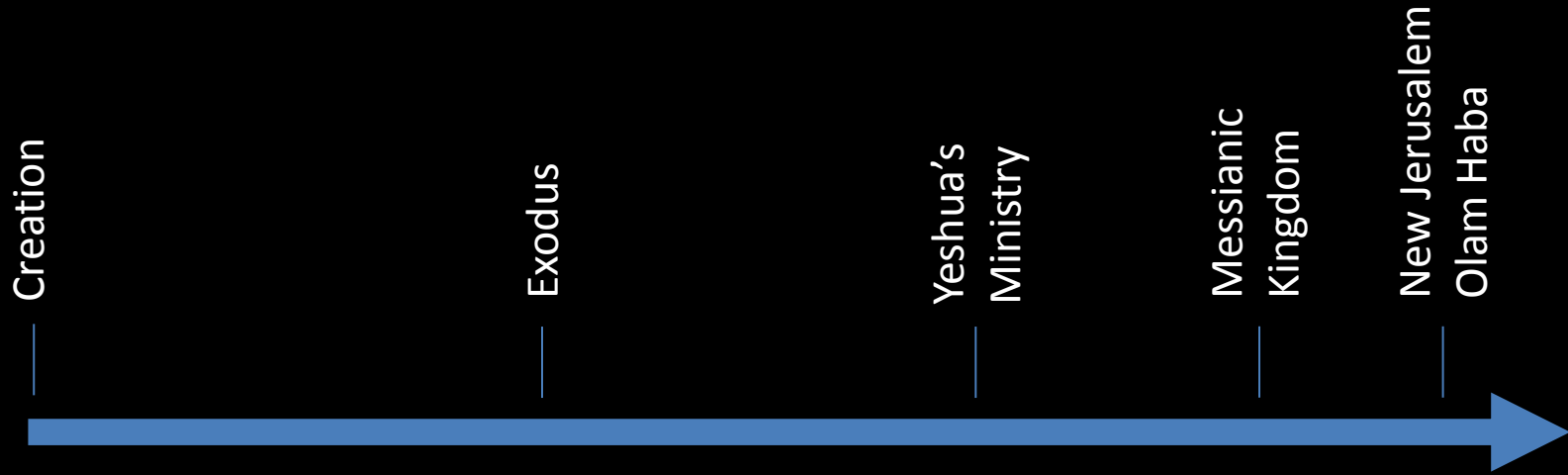

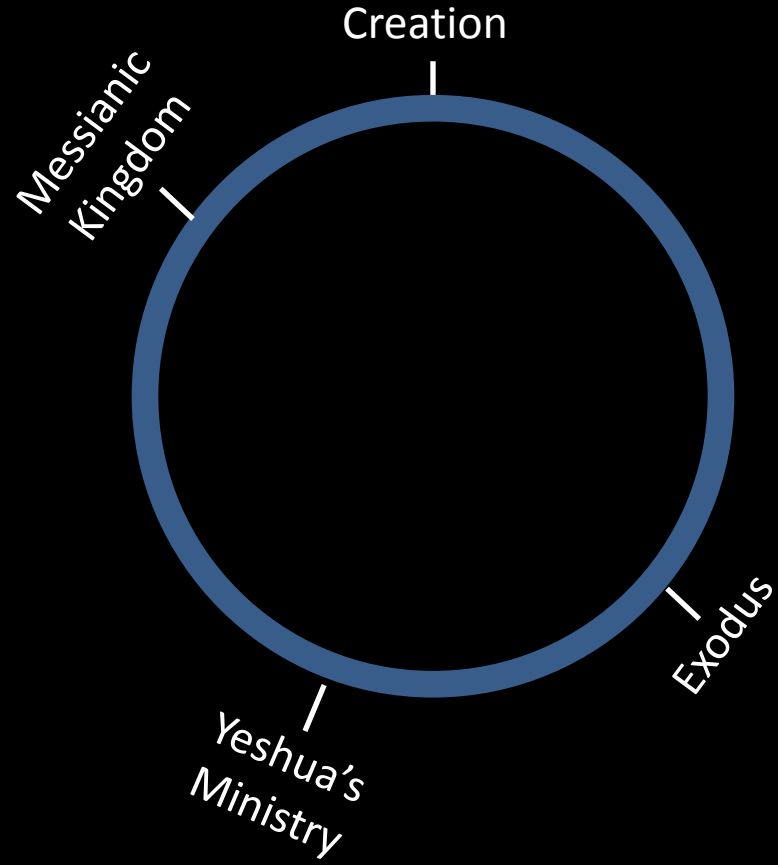

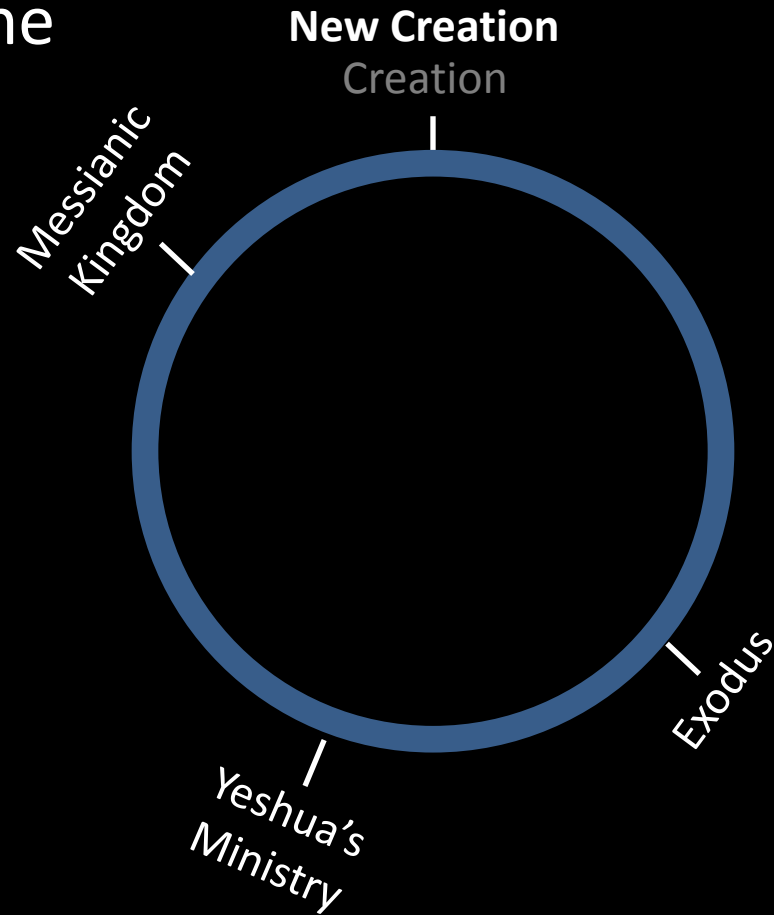
Typical “Greek” Timeline



Hebrew Timeline

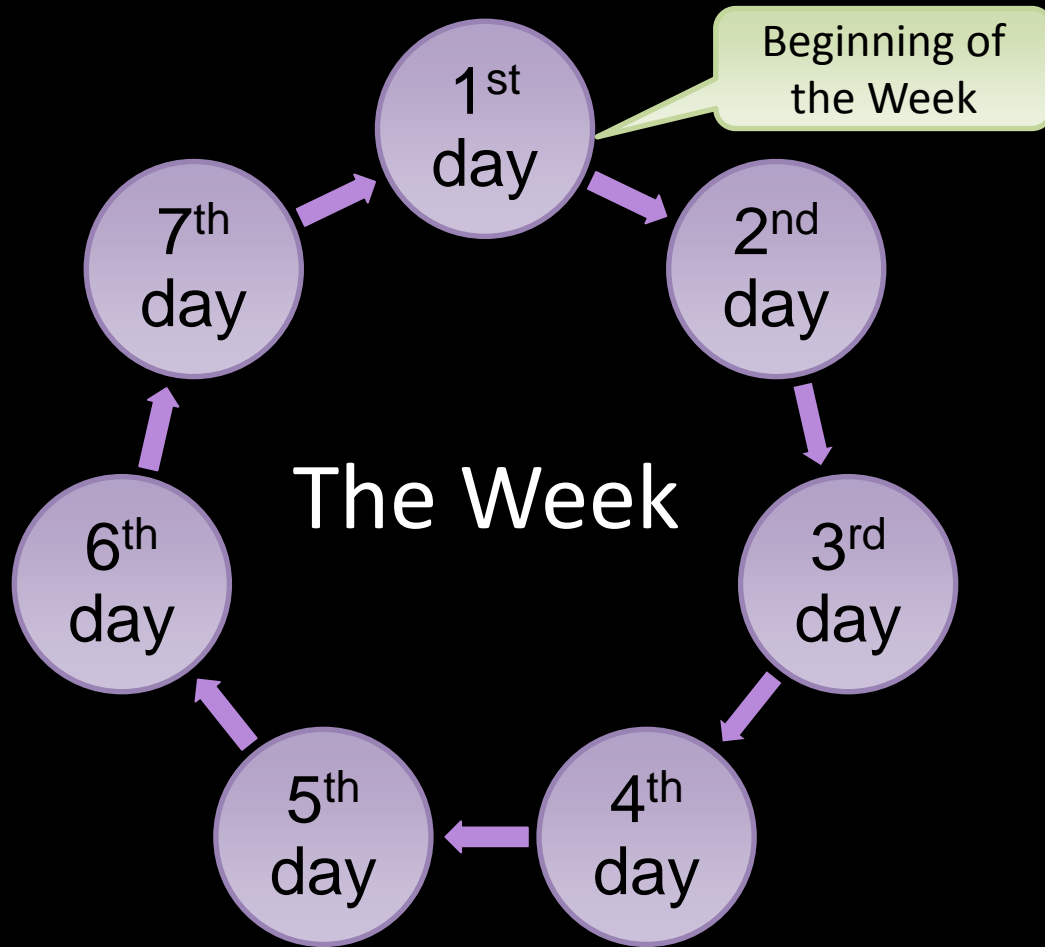

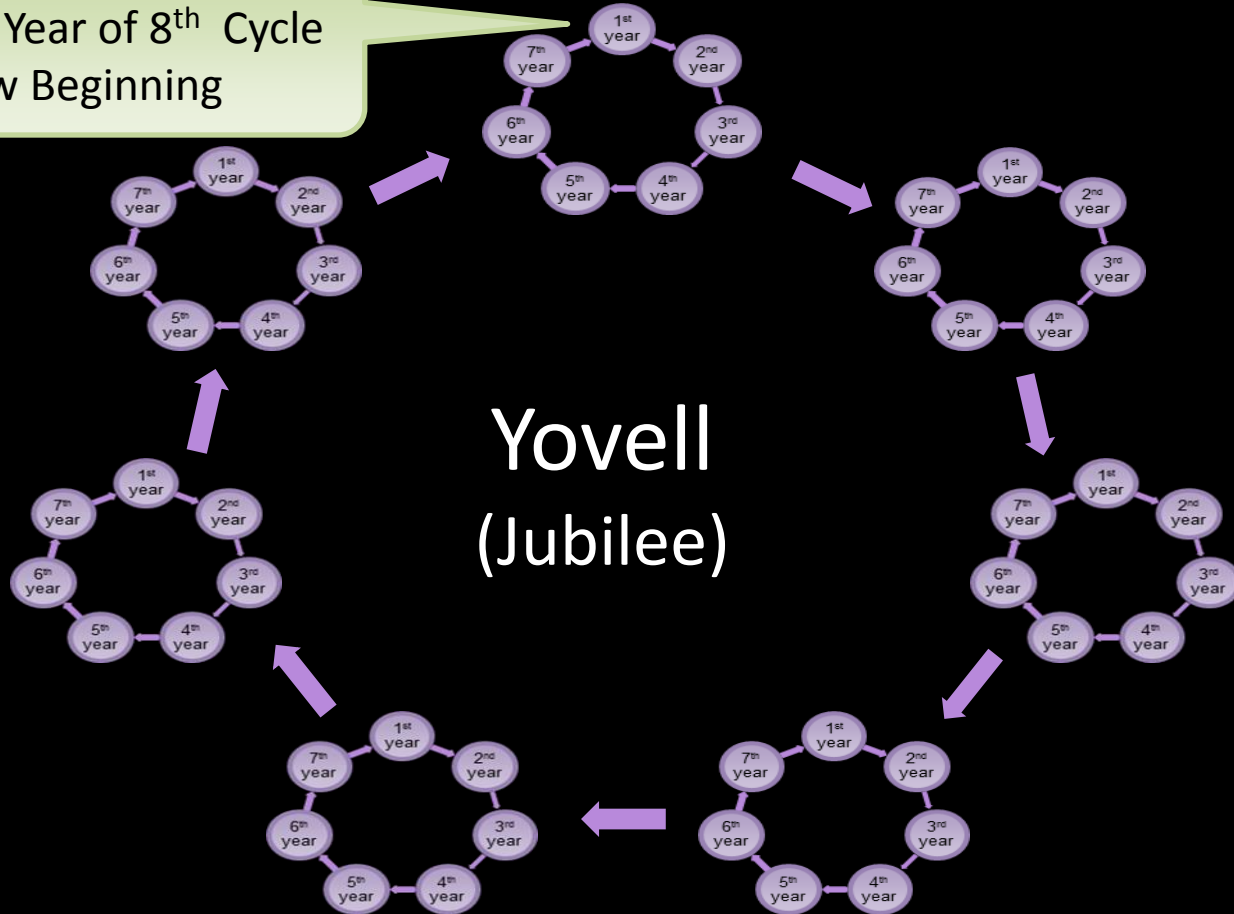
- Circumcision (Lev. 12:3)

- A child receives his/her name (Luke 1:59)

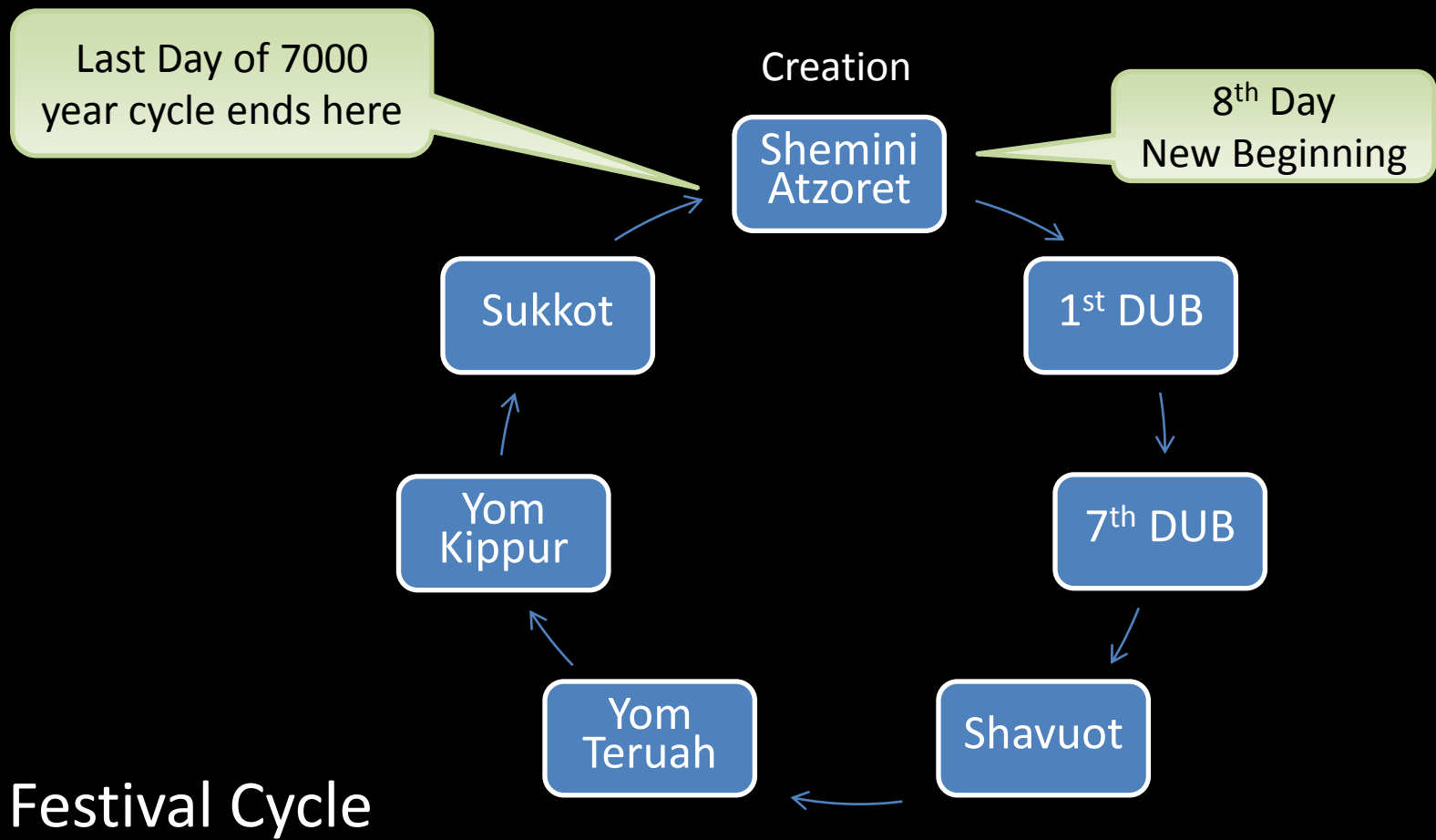


50th / 1st Day of 8th Week
