



# Part 2 Israel's Purpose



#### Prophetic Theme in the TNAKH

- Israel was called for a purpose to be a witness of God's grace
- Israel will be disobedient to that calling
- God will scatter them throughout the nations, but
- When they come to their senses, God will, in grace, call them back to fulfill their purpose.

NKJ Deuteronomy 4:5-8 "Surely I have taught you statutes and judgments, just as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should act according to them in the land which you go to possess. 6 "Therefore be careful to observe them; for this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples who will hear all these statutes, and say, 'Surely this great nation *is* a wise and understanding people.' <sup>7</sup> "For what great nation is there that has God so near to it, as the LORD our God is to us, for whatever reason we may call upon Him? 8 "And what great nation is there that has such statutes and righteous judgments as are in all this law which I set before you this day?

NKJ Deuteronomy 29:22-28 "... the coming generation of your children who rise up after you, and the foreigner who comes from a far land, would say, when they see the plagues of that land and the sicknesses which the LORD has laid on it: ... <sup>24</sup> "... 'Why has the LORD done so to this land? What does the heat of this great anger mean?' 25 "Then people would say: 'Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD God of their fathers ... <sup>26</sup> 'for they went and served other Gods and worshiped them, Gods that they did not know and that He had not given to them ...

NKJ 1 Kings 8:46-50 "...48" and when they return to You with all their heart and with all their soul in the land of their enemies who led them away captive, and pray to You toward their land which You gave to their fathers, the city which You have chosen and the temple which I have built for Your name: 49 "then hear in heaven Your dwelling place their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause, 50 "and forgive Your people who have sinned against You, and all their transgressions which they have transgressed against You; and grant them compassion before those who took them captive, that they may have compassion on them ..."

NKJ Jeremiah 16:14-15 "Therefore behold, the days are coming," says the LORD, "that it shall no more be said, 'The LORD lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of Egypt,' 15 "but, 'The LORD lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north and from all the lands where He had driven them.' For I will bring them back into their land which I gave to their fathers.

NKJ Amos 9:8-9 "Behold, the eyes of the Lord God are on the sinful kingdom, And I will destroy it from the face of the earth; Yet I will not utterly destroy the house of Jacob," Says the LORD. 9 "For surely I will command, And will sift the house of Israel among all nations, As grain is sifted in a sieve; Yet not the smallest grain shall fall to the ground.

## David Unites the Kingdom

# Part 3 The Mystery Revealed



#### Review -

- God will sometimes conceal the understanding of His plans until things are in place for it to be revealed.
- To 'solve' a Biblical mystery requires wisdom, and wisdom comes from obeying God's word.
- Paul began to reveal the understanding of the mystery to the messianic congregation in Rome that was composed of both Jews and non-Jewish Israelites.
- 'Gentile Inclusion' was not the mystery since God always provided a pathway by which a 'gentile' could become a part of the Hebrew people.

#### Review -

- Israel was given a responsibility that they have yet to fulfill
- A key to understanding the mystery is to understand that it is about the Kingdom of God. The united kingdom of Israel and Judah under King David is the pattern for that kingdom.
- Israel only began to fulfill her purpose when she became one nation under the reigns of King David and King Solomon
- Israel has been a divided for the past 3000 years, and thus unable to fulfill her responsibility

So how can these two peoples — Israel and Judah — ever join back together as they were under King David? The answer is simple:

#### **THEY CAN'T!**

... unless the curse is removed.

And how can the curse be removed?

Well - THAT'S THE MYSTERY!

NKJ Jeremiah 31:31 "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make (cut) a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah ...



NKJ Isaiah 54:1-3 "Sing, O barren, You who have not borne! Break forth into singing, and cry aloud, You who have not labored with child! For more are the children of the desolate Than the children of the married woman," says the LORD. 2 "Enlarge the place of your tent, And let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; Do not spare; Lengthen your cords, And strengthen your stakes. 3 For you shall expand to the right and to the left, And your descendants will inherit the nations, And make the desolate cities inhabited ...

NKJ Isaiah 54:4-5 "... 4 "Do not fear, for you will not be ashamed; Neither be disgraced, for you will not be put to shame; For you will forget the shame of your youth, And will not remember the reproach of your widowhood anymore. <sup>5</sup> For your Maker is your husband, The LORD of hosts is His name; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth.

NKJ Ephesians 2:11-13 Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh -- who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands -- 12 that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. 13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.


