NKJ **Exo 12:3-11** "Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: 'On the tenth *day* of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of *his* father, a lamb for a household ... ⁵ `Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year ... ⁶ ... Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at twilight ... ¹¹ ... It is the LORD'S **Passover**."



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'pecach' (פֶּעַח - 06453)



NKJ **Num 9:2-3** "Let the children of Israel **keep** the Passover at its appointed time. ³
"On the fourteenth day of this month, at twilight, you shall **keep** it at its appointed time. According to all its rites and ceremonies you shall **keep** it."

‘asah’ (עָשָׂה - 06453)
to do, to fashion,
to accomplish

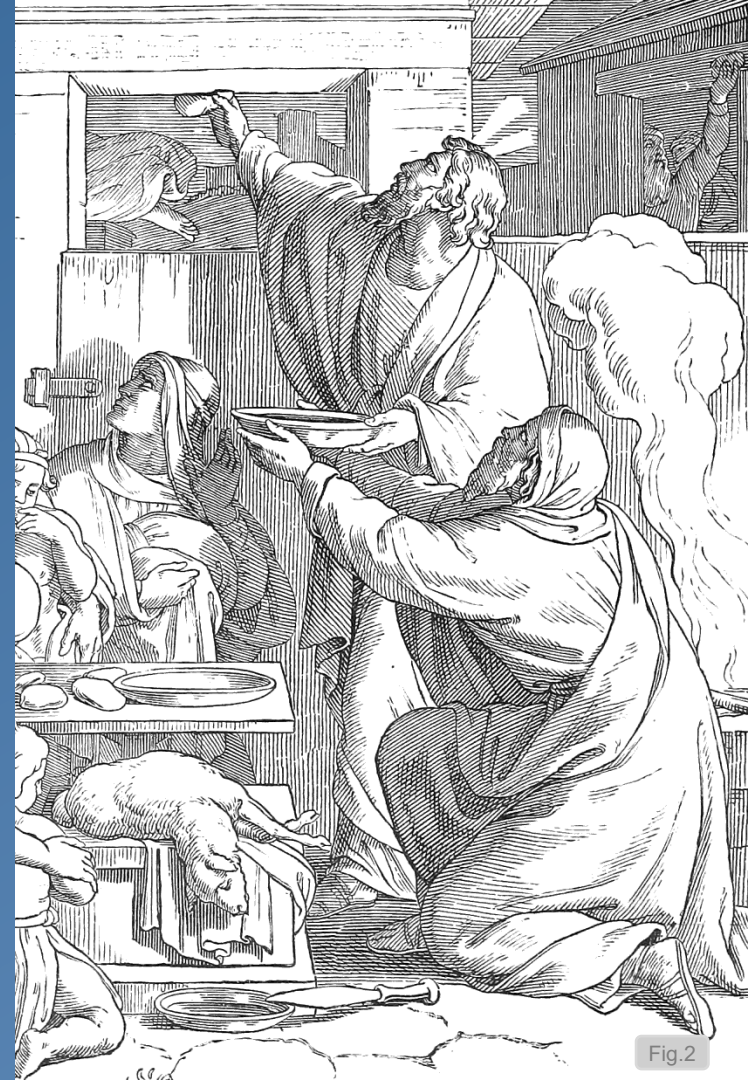

to skip, to limp

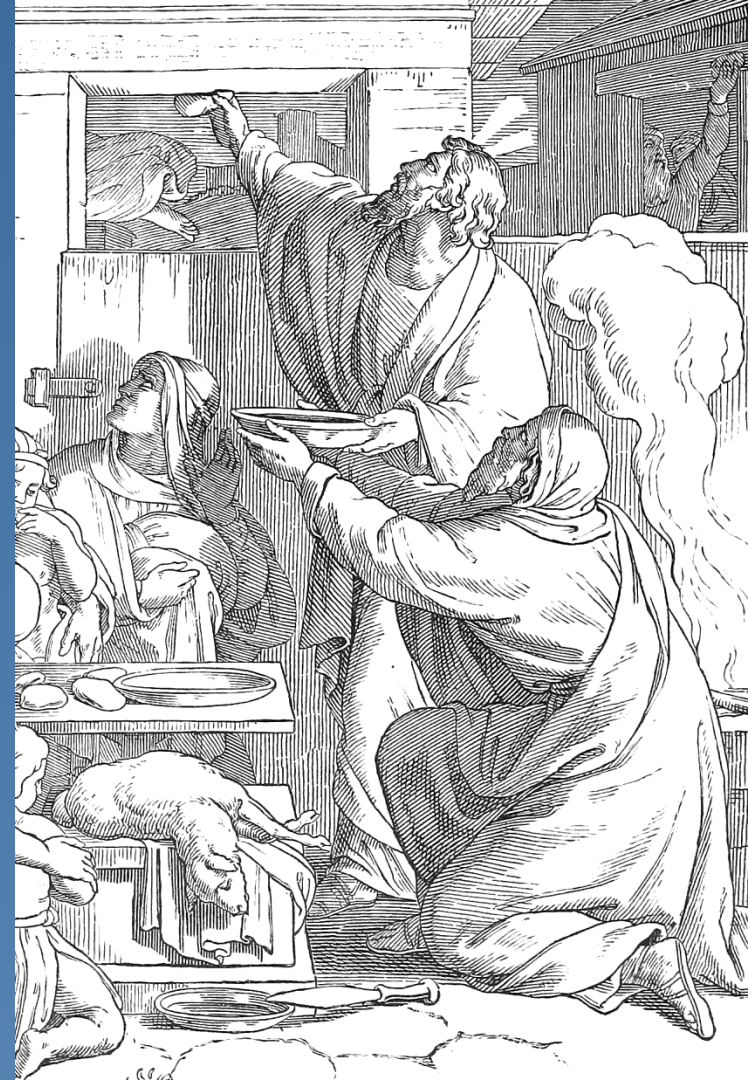
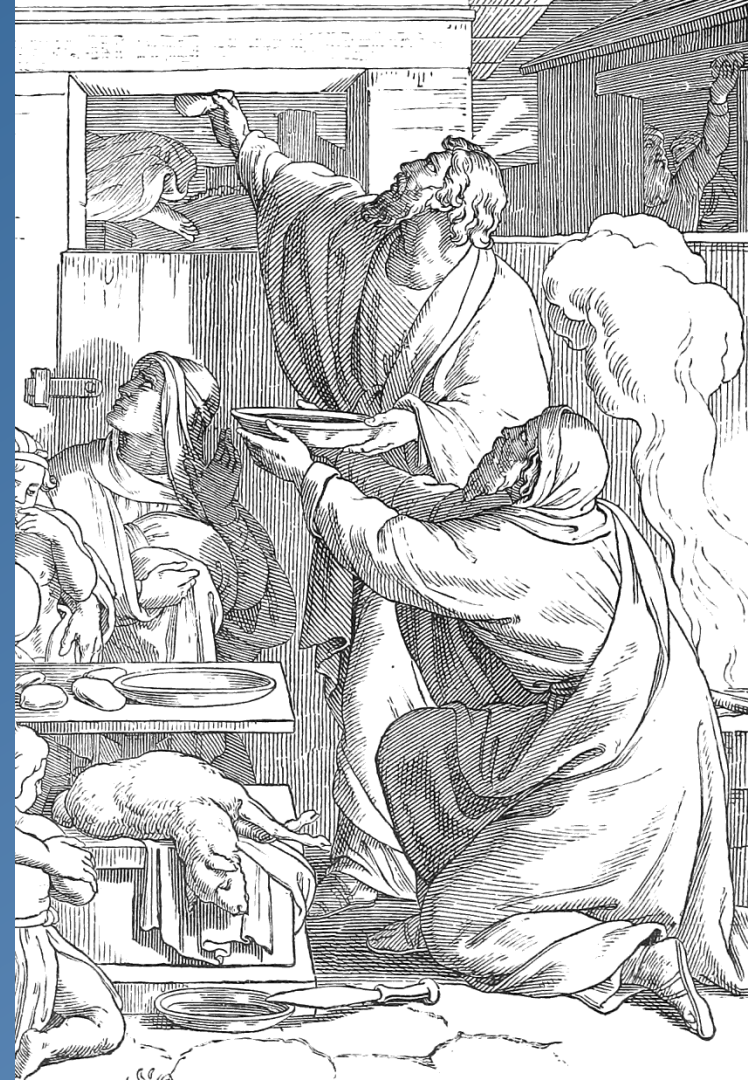


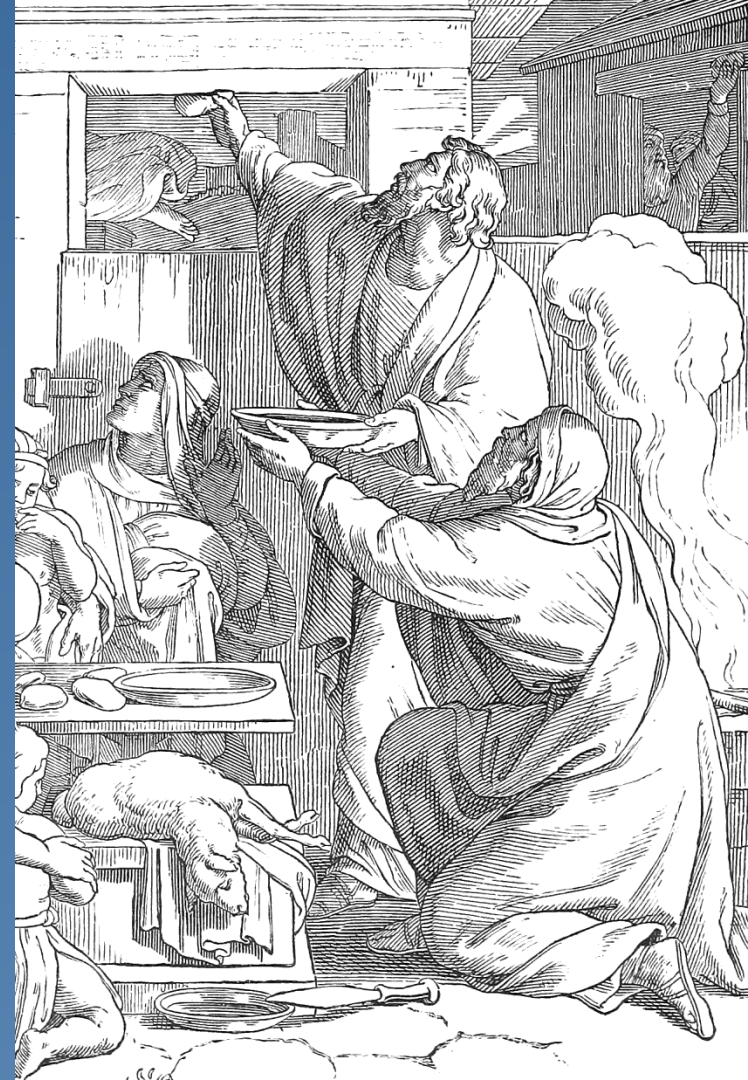

NKJ **Exodus 12:23** "For the LORD will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the LORD will **pass over** (pacach) **the door** and **not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you.**



NKJ Exodus 12:27 “...It is the Passover sacrifice of the LORD, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt when **He struck the Egyptians and delivered our households ...**”



KJV **1 Kings 18:21** And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long **halt (pacach)** ye between two opinions? if the LORD *be* God, follow him: but if Baal, *then* follow him. And the people answered him not a word.

halt²  

[hawlt] Phonetic (Standard) IPA

verb (used without object)

- 1 to falter, as in speech, reasoning, etc.; be hesitant; [stumble](#).
- 2 to be in doubt; waver between alternatives; [vacillate](#).
- 3 *Archaic.* to be lame; walk lamely; limp.

adjective

- 1 *Archaic.* lame; limping.

Antonyms: [sickly](#)

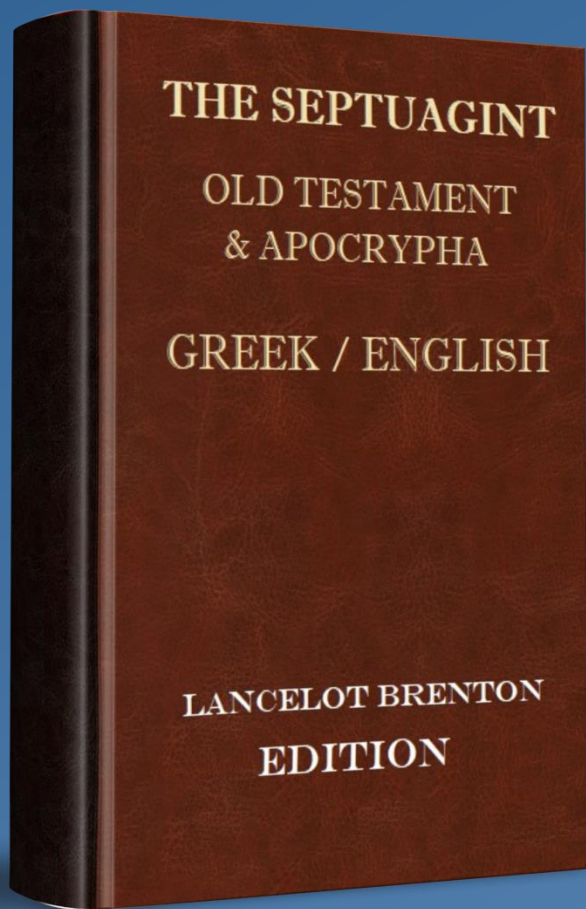
Limping = Hopping = Halting?

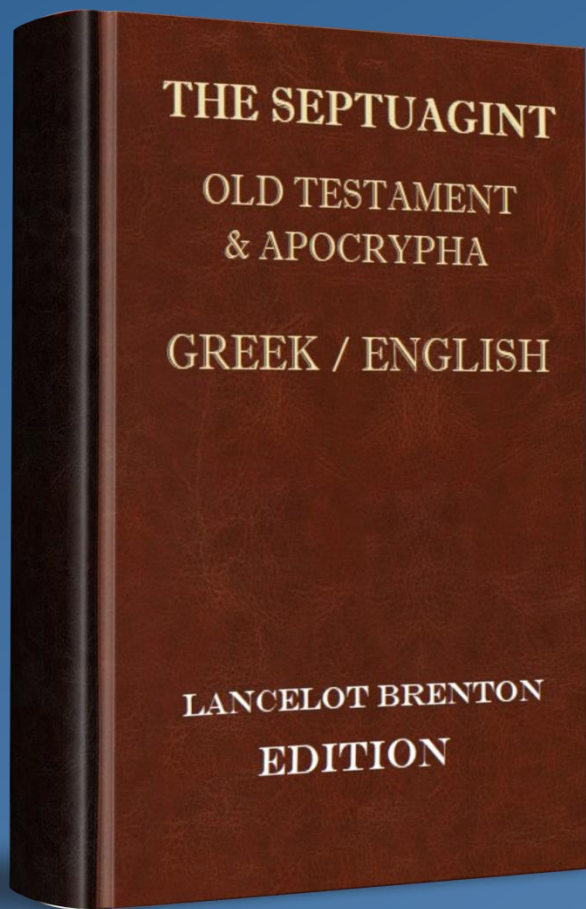

NKJ **Isaiah 31:5** Like birds **flying about**, So will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem. Defending, He will also deliver *it*; **Passing over (pacach)**, He will preserve *it*."

ESV **Isaiah 31:5** ^aLike birds **hovering**, so the LORD of hosts will protect Jerusalem; he will **protect and deliver** it; he will spare and rescue it."



NKJ **Deu 32:9-11** For the LORD'S portion *is* His people; Jacob *is* the place of His inheritance. ¹⁰ "He found him in a desert land and in the wasteland, a howling wilderness; He encircled him, He instructed him, He kept him as the apple of His eye. ¹¹ **As an eagle stirs up its nest, Hovers over its young, Spreading out its wings, taking them up, Carrying them on its wings ...**
