2247 חֲבַה chabah	Isaiah 26:20-21 ¹⁰ Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee: hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be overpast. ²¹ For, behold, the LORD cometh out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity: the earth also shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain.
2934 טָמֵן taman	Isaiah 2:10-12 ¹⁰ Enter into the rock, and hide thee in the dust, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty. ¹¹ The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. ¹² For the day of the LORD of hosts <i>shall be</i> upon every one <i>that is</i> proud and lofty, and upon every one <i>that is</i> lifted up; and he shall be brought low:
3680 קָכָה kakah	Psalm 143:9 ⁹ Deliver me, O LORD, from mine enemies: I flee unto thee to hide me.
5641 סְתַّר cathar	Psalm 17:8-9 ⁸ Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings, ⁹ From the wicked that oppress me, <i>from</i> my deadly enemies, <i>who</i> compass me about. Psalm 31:19-20 ¹⁹ Oh how great <i>is</i> thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; <i>which</i> thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men! ²⁰ Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues. 6845 צָפֵן tsaphan	Job 14:13-15 ¹³ O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave, that thou wouldest keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou wouldest appoint me a set time, and remember me! ¹⁴ If a man die, shall he live <i>again?</i> all the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come. ¹⁵ Thou shalt call, and I will answer thee: thou wilt have a desire to the work of thine hands. Psalm 27:5 ⁵ For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock. 4268 מַחְסֵה machaceh	Proverbs 14:26 ²⁶ In the fear of the LORD <i>is</i> strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge .
4498 מִנּוֹך manowc	2 Samuel 22:3-4 ³ The God of my rock; in him will I trust: <i>he is</i> my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge , my saviour; thou savest me from violence. ⁴ I will call on the LORD, <i>who is</i> worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies. Psalm 59:16 ¹⁶ But I will sing of thy power; yea, I will sing aloud of thy mercy in the morning: for thou hast been my defence and refuge in the day of my trouble. 4869 מִשְׁגָּב misgab	Psalm 9:9-10 ⁹ The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. ¹⁰ And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.
4422 מִלְט malat	Genesis 19:17 ¹⁷ And it came to pass, when they had brought them forth abroad, that he said, Escape for thy life; look not behind thee, neither stay thou in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed.
6403 פָּלָט palat	Ezekiel 7:15-16 ¹⁵ The sword <i>is</i> without, and the pestilence and the famine within: he that <i>is</i> in the field shall die with the sword; and he that <i>is</i> in the city, famine and pestilence shall devour him. ¹⁶ But they that escape of them shall escape , and shall be on the mountains like doves of the valleys, all of them mourning, every one for his iniquity.
