WHY TEACH THE SCRIPTURES?

^{ESV} **Deuteronomy 4:5-8** See, I have taught you statutes and rules, as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should do them in the land that you are entering to take possession of it. ⁶ Keep them and do them, for that will be your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples, **who, when they hear all these statutes,** will say, 'Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.' ⁷ For what great nation is there that has a god so near to it as the LORD our God is to us, whenever we call upon him? ⁸ And what great nation is there, that has statutes and rules so righteous as all this law that I set before you today?

WHY TEACH THE SCRIPTURES?

ESV **1 Peter 2:9** But you are a chosen race, a **royal priesthood**, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may **proclaim the excellences** of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

WHY TEACH THE SCRIPTURES?

ESV **John 15:1-2, 8, 16** - "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. ² Every branch in me that does not **bear fruit** he takes away, and every branch that does **bear fruit** he prunes, that it may **bear more fruit** ... ⁸ By this my Father is glorified, that you **bear much fruit** and so prove to be my disciples ... ¹⁶ You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and **bear fruit** and that your fruit should abide ...

ESV **Proverbs 11:18** The wicked earns deceptive wages, but one who sows righteousness **gets a sure reward.**

WHY TEACH THE SCRIPTURES?

ESV **John 4:35-36** Do you not say, 'There are yet four months, then comes the harvest'? Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest. ³⁶ Already the one who reaps is **receiving wages** and **gathering fruit for eternal life**, so that sower and reaper may rejoice together.

WHY TEACH THE SCRIPTURES?

NKJ 1 Cor. 12:27-31 - Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. ²⁸ **And God has appointed these in the church:** first apostles, second prophets, third **teachers** (didaskalos), after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues. ²⁹ *Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles?* ³⁰ *Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret?* ³¹ But **earnestly desire (burn with zeal) the best gifts**. And yet I show you a more excellent way.

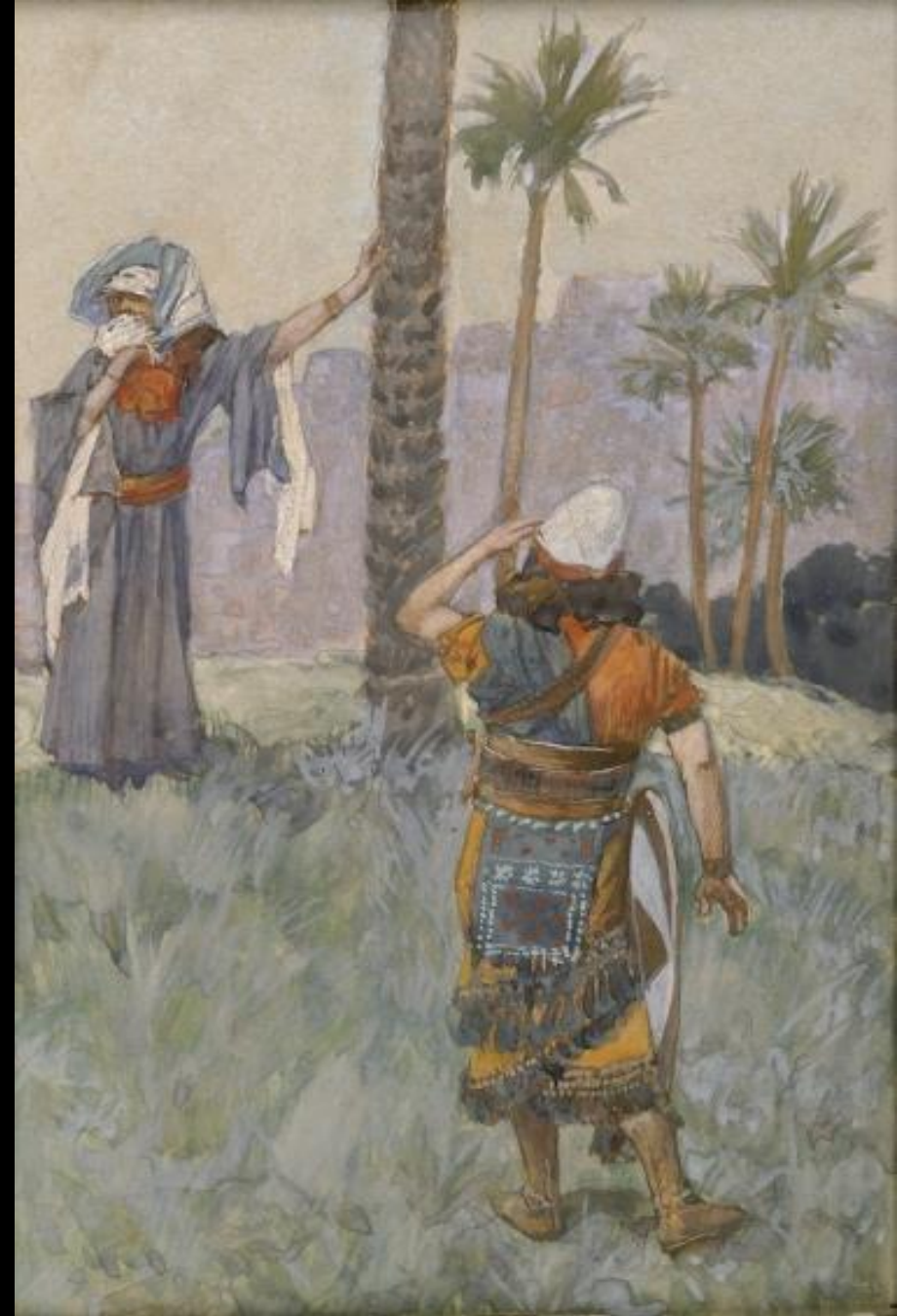
