


The Kingdom Divides

- God gives 10 tribes to Jeroboam
- Rehoboam (Solomon's son) tries to hang on the kingdom by being anointed king in Shechem.
 - Reheboam heeds unwise council
- The northern tribes secede

Jeroboam becomes king over Israel

Characteristics of Israel the Northern Tribes

- Worshiped God via idols (golden calves)
- Made priests from all the people
- Changed the festivals (Sukkot)
- Instituted new festivals
- Made offerings on various altars
- Attempted to mimic the proper order of worship that God had previously established
