 - various sacrifices
 - daily sacrifices (doubled)
 - for Aaron
 - for Israel
 - 2 goats 1 sacrifice
 - "for the lord" = sin sacrifice represents Yeshua unintentional sins (Heb. 9:7)
 - "for azazel" = takes sins away represents Yeshua (Hebrews 9 & 10)

- Betrothal (Shavuot)
- Snatching the Bride (Yom Teruah)
- Leaving the Chuppah (Yom Kippur)
- Wedding Feast (Sukkot)
- New Life Together (Shemini Atzoreth)

Misunderstood Terms:

- First trumpet = betrothal of Israel at Mount Sinai
- Last trumpet = fetching away of the bride.
 Announces the arrival of the bridegroom. Yom Teruah
- Great trumpet = Yom Kippur
- Day of the Lord / In that day = the "birthpains" (Joel 2:1,11; Is. 2:12, 13:6; Jer. 46:10; Ezek. 30:3; 2 Peter 3:10)

Fall Festivals: Yom Teruah (Feast of Trumpets)


NKJ 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17 But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. ¹⁴ For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. ¹⁵ For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. ¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. NKJ **Jeremiah 4:13** "Behold, he (*Nebuchadnezzar's army*) shall come up like **clouds**, And his chariots like a whirlwind. His horses are swifter than eagles. Woe to us, for we are plundered!"

NKJ **Ezekiel 30:1-4** The word of the LORD came to me again, saying, ² "Son of man, prophesy and say, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Wail, 'Woe to the day!' ³ For the day *is* near, Even the **day of the LORD** *is* near; It will be a day of **clouds**, the time of the Gentiles. ⁴ The sword shall come upon Egypt, And great anguish shall be in Ethiopia ...

Going Up to Jerusalem!

ESV Isaiah 49:22-23 Thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, I will lift up my hand to the nations, and raise my signal to the peoples; and they shall bring your sons in their bosom, and your daughters shall be carried on their shoulders. ²³ Kings shall be your foster fathers, and their queens your nursing mothers. With their faces to the ground they shall bow down to you, and lick the dust of your feet. Then you will know that I am the LORD; those who wait for me shall not be put to shame."

The Mount of Olives

The Mount of Olives

Restoring the Kingdom

ESV Isaiah 11:14-16 ... they shall swoop down on the shoulder of the Philistines in the west, and together they shall plunder the people of the east. They shall put out their hand against Edom and Moab, and the Ammonites shall obey them. ¹⁵ And the LORD will utterly destroy the tongue of the Sea of Egypt, and will wave his hand over the River with his scorching breath, and strike it into seven channels, and he will lead people across in sandals. ¹⁶ And there will be a highway from Assyria for the remnant that remains of his people, as there was for Israel when they came up from the land of Egypt.
